Here are some things to consider when making your decision to volunteer at the S.P.C.A.:

- You're likely to get dirty! Please wear working clothes. Good shoes are important when working with the animals. Also, cats and kittens sometimes cling to the person holding them, so t-shirts with sleeves are a better option than tank tops.
- Juniors generally volunteer as Cat Helpers. This involves scooping litter, doing laundry, mopping floors, washing dishes, etc. Between the cat poop and cat food, it can be a smelly task. If strong smells bother you, Shelter Work might not be for you!
- You may occasionally be asked to help with office work that includes stuffing envelopes and stamping Newsletters!
- Please notify the S.P.C.A. if you cannot make your regularly scheduled time. With advance notice, we can try to schedule another volunteer to fill your space.
- Junior Volunteers must be willing to take direction from members of Staff. We are here to prevent accidents and ensure the safety of our volunteers and our animals.
- Of course, once the work is finished, we encourage our Volunteers to spend time socializing with the animals. Please ask about the dogs before approaching them.
